All four of the airy ensuite bedrooms at this handsome Victorian B&B have sweeping sea views over the rooftops of St Ives towards Godrevy Lighthouse. Formerly a sea captain's residence, it's splashed in subtle ocean greens and Cornish blues, with driftwood artworks and a decked terrace gazing across the bay. As for location, you're a five-minute walk from glorious Porthminster Beach, and 10 minutes from the Barbara Hepworth Museum and the watersports school on Porthmeor Beach.
